London, 23-27 February 2023

Important info:

1. Students manage their own travel, accommodation, and insurance.
2. The compulsory part of the excursion includes visit of famous historical sites and cultural institutions (e.g. Westminster Abbey, Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Downing Street, White Hall, St. James's Park, Hyde Park, Buckingham Palace, Piccadilly Circus, Soho, China Town, Baker Street, Leicester Square, Covent Garden, Trafalgar Square, Kensington Palace, Albert Memorial, Royal Albert Hall, St. Paul's Cathedral, Globe Theatre, National Gallery, Natural History Museum, Science Museum, British Museum, Charles Dickens' Museum, Tower Bridge, Tower of London, Golden Jubilee Bridge, London Eye, The City of London, The Shard, The Gherkin, HMS Belfast, etc.).
3. Based on the mandatory part of the excursion (+ anything extra), students develop a multimedia project (e.g. video film) for which they will receive credit at the end of the semester. The exact list of required activities and grading criteria will be posted no later than the 1st week of the semester in the MOODLE course.
4. For safety reasons, we recommend traveling and living in groups (e.g. with classmates).
5. Visiting London is not limited to KAJL students, you can invite friends, friends, relatives, etc. However, only KAJL students will receive credits 😊
6. After returning from the excursion, we will post the final projects from the excursion on the departmental FB page and on the KAJL YouTube channel. The best films (with most likes) will be announced at the end of the semester and their authors will receive an extra scholarship.
7. The first meeting will be on 2/24/2023 at 9:00 am in Trinity Square Gardens at the anchor (Memory of Merchant Seafarers, Tower Hill Underground stop, Circle & District lines). We will then walk the sights on both sides of the Thames (comfortable shoes compulsory 😊).
8. For the purpose of the excursion, a separate team will be created in MS Teams, through which all participants will be in contact with each other and where we will always arrange the next day's programme in the evening, or changes in the programme due to the weather (it almost always rains in London in February!). Keep an eye out for ongoing and updated announcements in MOODLE and on the Department's FB.
9. You can also take the excursion independently and on other dates (during term time). In this case, students will also complete the tasks and develop a multimedia project according to the assignments in MOODLE.
10. Excuses for classes should be requested from Mrs. Rapantova (KAJL secretary).
