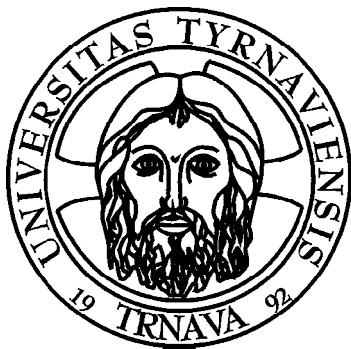

Conference Venue

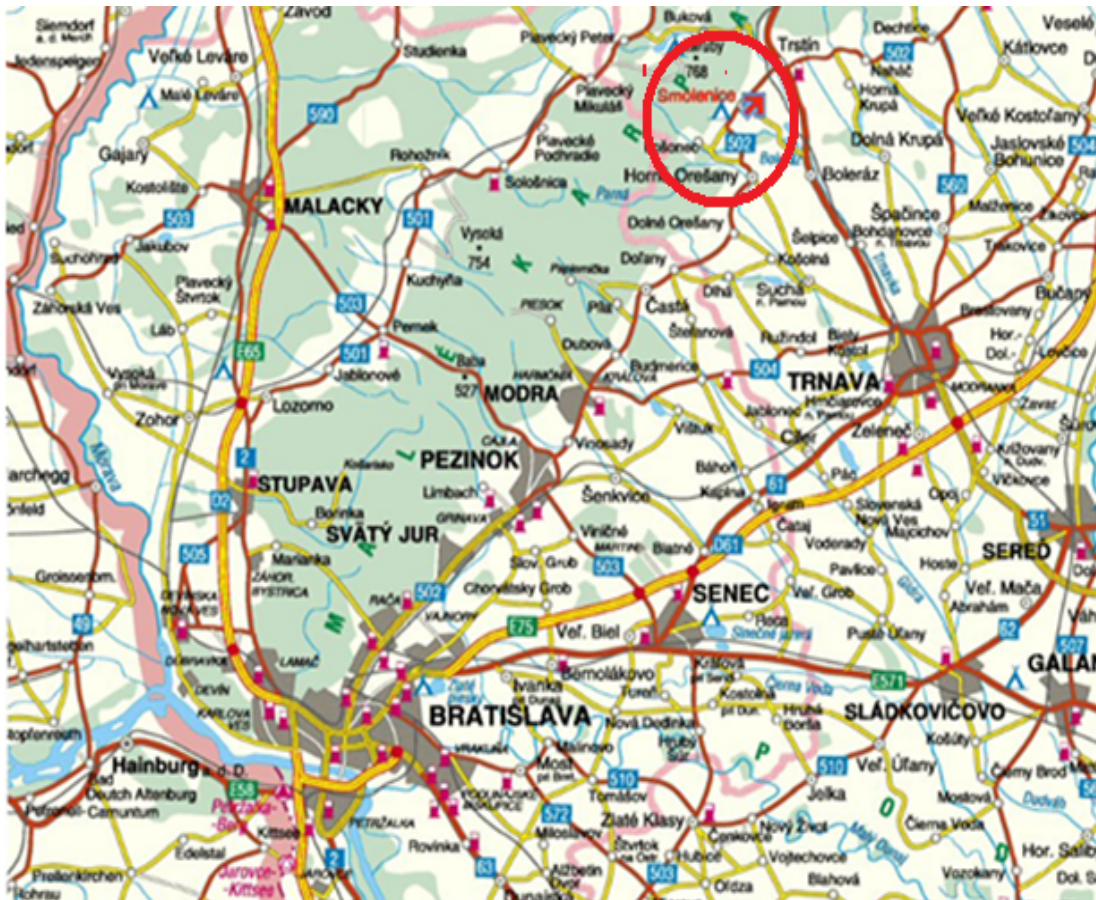
Congress Centre Smolenice of the Slovak Academy of Sciences (SAS)
